Dear Mr. President:

On behalf of the Commonwealth of Virginia, we write to express our support for Governor Bob McDonnell's request for a Major Disaster Declaration for Public Assistance for 47 counties and 15 independent cities across the Commonwealth of Virginia and statewide Hazard Mitigation as a result of the severe storms that occurred between June 29 and July 1, 2012.

The storm that took place on June 29-30, characterized as a derecho and bringing winds as high as 80-100 mph, and the heavy thunderstorms with high winds and hail that occurred on June 30 and July 1 caused the loss of 15 lives and significant disruptions and damage to communications and transportation systems, electrical utilities, and medical and health facilities. Dangerously high temperatures that persisted during and after the storms exacerbated the severe weather damage and widespread power outages—some of which lasted longer than seven days and left homes and businesses without power in addition to severely impacting agricultural operations and infrastructure. A State of Emergency Declaration remains in effect in the Commonwealth, with 47 jurisdictions having declared a local emergency.


We commend the many first responders and linemen, the localities, and the Commonwealth for their swift response to these emergencies and their ongoing recovery efforts. These communities are overwhelmed by the destruction caused by the storms and need supplemental federal assistance specifically for debris removal, emergency protective measures, and permanent work. After conducting a Joint Preliminary Damage Assessment, Governor McDonnell has requested statewide Hazard Mitigation and Public Assistance for the counties of Albemarle, Alleghany, Amelia, Amherst, Appomattox, Arlington, Augusta, Bath, Bedford, Bland, Botetourt, Buckingham, Campbell, Carroll, Charlotte, Clarke, Craig, Culpeper, Cumberland, Dinwiddie, Fauquier, Floyd, Fluvanna, Frederick, Giles, Greene, Halifax, Highland, Louisa, Lunenburg, Madison, Nelson, New Kent, Nottoway, Orange, Page, Pittsylvania, Powhatan, Prince Edward, Pulaski, Rappahannock, Roanoke, Rockbridge, Rockingham, Shenandoah, Tazewell, and Warren and the cities of Bedford, Charlottesville, Covington, Danville, Fairfax, Fredericksburg, Lexington, Lynchburg, Manassas Park, Martinsville, Radford, Roanoke, Salem, Staunton, and Winchester.

Pursuant to the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, we respectfully request that you grant Governor McDonnell's request for public assistance and hazard mitigation for the Commonwealth of Virginia. Thank you for your expeditious consideration of this request.




